Practice and Game Location

Each 49ers team may have the following team officials as selected by the Head Coach at the start of each season to assist with team operations.

- Head Coach
- Assistant Coaches
- Manager
- Trainer
- Treasurer, responsible for maintaining accurate financial records and ensures timely payment of all team activities.
- Parent Representative, a mediator to address any issues within the team between players, parents, and team officials. All team issues (other than Abuse and Harassment) must be dealt with at the team level first through the Parent Representative.
- Website Manager responsible for ensuring the team's portion of the 49ers website is up to date. These tasks include news articles, game results, uploading sponsorships and other team-related information.

All Team Officials must be approved by the 49ers organization before participating in team activities and must complete a Vulnerable Sector Check every three years.

Evaluation Policy

- 3 optional pre-skates, \$50, sold as a package
- A and B tryout fees, \$100
- B *only* tryout fees, \$75
- 3 tryout guarantee

Players must attend a minimum of 1 tryout to be considered for a team. Players are eligible to try out for other zones, so long as they meet the tryout requirements for that zone. Once a player signs with a team at any level, they are no longer eligible to attend further tryouts with any other team.

Registration Fees

Includes 20-game league schedule, practices, certified coaching, nutritional information, skills development, off-ice conditioning, game jerseys, socks and a hat. Does not include tournament fees.
